The Construction Partnership Program (CPP) is a joint agency effort underway to prepare for

the unprecedented amount of infrastructure improvements scheduled to take place throughout Central Texas over the next 10 years.

Between highway reconstruction, a brand new transit system build-out, an international airport expansion, a convention center redevelopment and expansion as well as multiple private development projects, coordinating construction is essential.

The CPP will enable agency partners to better coordinate with each other, inform the public, and keep Central Texas moving throughout peak construction, as well as set a foundation for long-term interagency coordination, mobility and safety enhancements.
