

CONSTRUCTION COORDINATION

The Construction Partnership Program (CPP) is a joint agency effort that will enhance construction coordination during the execution of more than \$20 billion in planned infrastructure projects around Central Texas over the next 10 years.

Early and effective construction coordination between the agencies building these large projects will improve public safety while reducing combined impacts on residents, businesses, and travelers when possible.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF CONSTRUCTION COORDINATION?

- CPP partner agencies will identify potential project conflicts early, so they can start multi-agency coordination in order to mitigate significant impacts.
- Advance identification of impacts will allow CPP partners to share information with the public about upcoming travel route changes and delays as early as possible through the CPP public information platform.

HOW WILL CPP CONSTRUCTION COORDINATION WORK?

INPUT DATA

CPP Partners enter major construction closure, detour, and schedule information into a centralized platform.



PERFORM ANALYSES

CPP operations teams perform analyses of data to determine where construction conflicts might exist.



SHARE INFORMATION

CPP Partners use data to inform decision-making & share potential impacts through the public information platform.
