PUBLIC INFORMATION

The Construction Partnership Program (CPP) is a joint agency effort that will create a “One-Stop-Shop” for construction information during the execution of more than \$20 billion in planned infrastructure projects around Central Texas over the next 10 years.

CPP partners will create a public information platform that will share timely and transparent messages about lane closures and potential traffic impacts through a range of communication channels, ensuring that residents, businesses, and travelers receive the information they need to plan their trips.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF A PUBLIC INFORMATION PLATFORM?

- ✓ With an easy to remember phone number and website address, the CPP’s public information platform will serve as a one-stop-shop for routing the public’s construction-related questions and concerns to the appropriate project owner.
- ✓ This one-stop shop will enable the CPP team to communicate potential issues resulting from the combined impact of construction projects to the public.

PUBLIC INFORMATION PLATFORM



Subscribers to the public information platform view closures and detours online or receive traffic updates on their favorite routes by text and email.

PUBLIC INFORMATION CHANNELS



The public information platform feeds data to a variety of navigation services, so planned routes account for active construction closures.

CONSTRUCTION ONE-STOP-SHOP



The public submits construction questions to the public information platform, with inquiries routed to the agency in charge of each project.
